Continues: **	Jr. may continue till 10 pts. Am may continue Class may be combined with Jr/Am if less than 5 entries. Highest placing riders in each age group will both be champions in their respective age group. In the Finals the top rider 36 and over will be recognized by receiving a special award.

Restrictions:	None

Work off:	2 USEF tests (1,2,6,10,12,15,17,18) included in course		
Qualifies:	21/U riders = 6 pts Am 22/O and Jr 14/U = ride in one class 30 or more entries will receive double points		
Continues:	Past Champions and current competitors may continue to ride for year-end hi pt award		
Name:	<b>CPHA Child/Adult</b>	Age:	<b>Child/Adult</b>
Memberships:	CPHA – Trainers and Riders	Enter / Complete:	3 to compete 3 to complete
Restrictions:	Never won any medal, equitation, hunter or jumper class with fences 3'3" or higher within the last 10 years. Any rider competing currently or within the last 10 years at 3'6" or higher is also not eligible to compete in this class.		
Height:	3'		
Work off:	Work off = 2 minimum(Judges' discretion) USEF tests 1-8		
Qualifies:	3 pts. 6, 4,3,2,1 (5 entries) 4,3,2,1 (4 entries) etc.		

Name:	<b>CPHA Horsemanship</b>	Age:	<b>Junior/Amateur</b>
Memberships:	CPHA: Trainers and Riders	Enter / Complete	3 to compete 3 to complete
Restrictions	Never won any medal, equitation, hunter or jumper class with fences 3' or higher within the last 10 years. Any rider competing currently or within the last 10 years at 3'3" or higher is also not eligible to compete in this class.		
Height:	2'6"		
Work off:	One test (of either halt or trot) in course, No combinations		
Qualifies:	3 pts. 6, 4,3,2,1 (with 5 entries) 4,3,2,1 (4 entries) etc		

Note: Foundation and WCE Classes with 30 or more entries receive double points.

Classes with 50 or more may be split (California Split) This includes all CPHA Classes.

Continues:	Past Champions and current competitors may continue to ride for year-end hi pt award.
